The Centre des Premières Nations Nikanite and its partners are setting up "School Perseverance for First Peoples" scholarship funds 2017-2018 to highlight perseverance of First Peoples students.

The scholarships are intended for Secondary 4 and Secondary 5 students. A scholarship will be awarded to deserving students from each of the 11 autochthonous nations to encourage their progress and their daily efforts throughout their school careers.
