Bus Strike Tuesday, May 15

As per media reports, more than 2,100 school bus drivers across Quebec are threatening to walk off the job (strike) this coming Tuesday, May 15th. These drivers are members of the Confédération des syndicats nationaux (CSN) which is coordinating the strike.

This job action will affect two bus companies which service LBPSB schools, Autobus Transco and Group Seguin. The situation is very fluid and it may be as late as the morning of May 15th before we know the unions' intentions for certain. We must plan ahead, however, and anticipate that there may be an interruption.

All Lindsay Place High School parents potentially affected by a strike on Tuesday received a detailed email on Wednesday, May 9th. At this point in time, we are simply confirming information which has already been shared. We will continue to monitor the situation and communicate to the community should the situation change.

For strike affected students in Secondary V who are scheduled to write the first section of their French 2nd Language 634-520 exam on May 15th, accommodations will be made in the event of a transportation problem.
