



MOBILE PHONES, IPADS & ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Students are expected to be responsible digital citizens with respect to school and personal electronic devices (including cell phones).

Students are not permitted to use electronic devices to bully, harass, intimidate, or threaten the security and well-being of any member of the Lindsay Place community. Inappropriate messaging, cyber-misconduct, online harassment, hacking, etc. may result in severe consequences and/or police intervention.

Electronic devices are permitted during personal time (before school, recess, lunch, after school)

Personal electronic devices all have the potential to be disruptive to class activity. Devices are permitted in classrooms only when permission is granted by the teacher. Use of such devices during class time without permission from the teacher may lead to confiscation. If asked for the electronic device, the student must give it to the staff member.

Repeat offences against this policy may result in having to leave the electronic device at the main office during school hours.

The school is not responsible for the lost or stolen electronic devices.

Students are expected to use ear buds (or equivalent) to listen to audio from their device, unless given permission to do otherwise.

It is illegal to take unauthorized pictures, videos and sound clips on school property without appropriate consent.
