Interim Report	On October 15, you will receive an Interim Report which will include comments on your child's learning and behavior.
Term 1 Report Card	The Term 1 Report Card will be issued on November 19. This report card will cover the period from August 30 to November 4 and will count for 20% of the final mark for the year.
Term 2 Report Card	The Term 2 Report Card will be issued on February 21. This report card will cover the period from November 5 to February 6 and will count for 20% of the final mark for the year.
Term 3 Report Card	The Term 3 Report Card will be issued on June 26. It will cover the period from February 5 to the end of the year and will count for 60% of the final mark for the year.
