<b>Official Communications</b>	
<b>Interim Report</b>	On October 15, you will receive an Interim Report which will include comments on your child's learning and behavior.
<b>Term 1 Report Card</b>	The Term 1 Report Card will be issued on November 19. This report card will cover the period from August 30 to November 4 and will count for 20% of the final mark for the year.
<b>Term 2 Report Card</b>	The Term 2 Report Card will be issued on February 21. This report card will cover the period from November 5 to February 6 and will count for 20% of the final mark for the year.
<b>Term 3 Report Card</b>	The Term 3 Report Card will be issued on June 26. It will cover the period from February 10 to the end of the year and will count for 60% of the final mark for the year. <b>MEES will release final marks first week of July via Student portal.</b>
