**SECTION A – PROGRAMS**

**IMPORTANT:** *Students will continue in the same program they followed in Secondary II.* Any request to change to a different program must be made in writing to the Vice Principal. Admission to French Immersion or the Quantum Enriched Program is dependent on results achieved in Secondary II.

**English Program**

All courses taught in English EXCEPT French.

**Immersion Program**

**Quantum Enriched Program**

The following courses are taught in French: Histoire & French

- ✓ Enriched English
- ✓ Français Plus
- ✓ Enriched Math
- ✓ Enriched Science & Technology
- ✓ Histoire
- ✓ Physical Education
- ✓ One OR two options (see page 2)

**SECTION B – MATHEMATICS**

*Placement will be determined by results achieved in Secondary II, as well as teacher AND/OR administrator recommendation.*

- ◆ Math 306 – for students in the English and Immersion programs.
- ◆ Enriched Math 3 – for students who have already completed Math 306 in the Secondary II Quantum Program. This course allows students to earn 4 credits at the Secondary IV level.

**NOTE:** *EACH of these Math programs may lead to Scientific Math (SN) in Secondary IV.*

**SECTION C – SCIENCE**

Students in the Regular and Immersion Programs must choose:  General Science  Applied Science + POP (= 1 option)

Students in the Quantum Enriched Program will be placed in ENRICHED GENERAL SCIENCE.

**NOTE:** *EACH of these Science programs may lead to Advanced Science in Secondary IV.*

**SECTION D – SOCIAL STUDIES**

Students in the Regular Program will be placed in HISTORY (taught in English).

Students in the Immersion Program must choose:  History *or*  Histoire \*

Students in the Quantum Enriched Program will be placed in HISTOIRE (taught in French).

\* This is the prerequisite for the Bilingual Certificate upon graduation.

## SECTION E – OPTION(S)

**Students must be enrolled in 6 PERIODS of options:**

- You **MUST** choose at least one option in the ARTS category (column A).
- If you choose a 6-period Music option from Section 1, your requirements are complete.
- Otherwise, go to Section 2 and choose one from EACH column (A and B).
- Students who have chosen Applied Science **MUST** also choose the Personal Orientation Project (POP) as one of their options.

### 1. SIX-PERIOD OPTIONS – choose ONE only:

- Music Performance:       Band    OR     Strings
- Music – Etude program:       Band (by audition ONLY)

### 2. THREE-PERIOD COURSES – choose one from column A, PLUS one from column B:

**COLUMN A – Arts options – rank your choices 1 – 2:**

**COLUMN B – Other options – rank your choices 1 – 3:**

- Visual Arts
- Drama

- Forensic Science
- Personal Orientation Project (POP)
- Woodworking
- Sports Activities

## GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

As of June 2010, students must accumulate a total of at least 54 credits total @ Secondary IV and V, at least 20 of which **MUST** be Secondary V, including:

- ✓ Secondary IV Arts\*
- ✓ Secondary IV History & Citizenship
- ✓ Secondary IV Math
- ✓ Secondary IV Science
- ✓ Secondary V English
- ✓ Secondary V French
- ✓ Secondary V Phys. Ed. OR Ethics/Religious Culture
- ✓ Secondary V Arts

**IMPORTANT: These are the minimum requirements to graduate from high school, but **ADMISSION TO CEGEP IS NOT GUARANTEED.****
