SECTION B – SCIENCE & MATH PLACEMENT

Placement will be determined by results achieved in Secondary III, as well as teacher AND/OR administrator recommendation.

LPHS offers 2 Math courses in Secondary 4: Cultural/Social/Technical (CST) or Scientific (SN)

LPHS offers 3 Science courses in Secondary 4: Applied, General, or Advanced

- * **Advanced Science** is the prerequisite for Chemistry/Physics in Secondary 5, **OR** you must pass the bridge course in summer school.
- * You must achieve 75% or more in Secondary 3 Math.
- * If you choose Advanced Science, English will be taught 4 periods/cycle.

Students in the **Regular** and **Immersion** Programs must choose one of the following combinations:

- General** Science + Regular English
- Applied** Science + Regular English
- Advanced** Science + Advanced English

Students in the **Enriched** Program will be registered in:

- Advanced Science/Technology + SN Math + Enriched English

SECTION C – SOCIAL STUDIES PLACEMENT

Students must choose one of the following:

History (taught in English)

Histoire (taught in French)*

* You must achieve 70% or more in Secondary 3 French AND Histoire

* This is a prerequisite for the Bilingual Certificate upon graduation

As of June 2010, students must accumulate a total of at least 54 credits total @ Secondary IV and V, at least 20 of which MUST be Secondary V, including:

- ✓ Secondary IV History & Citizenship
- ✓ Secondary IV Math
- ✓ Secondary IV Science
- ✓ Secondary V English
- ✓ Secondary V French
- ✓ Secondary V Phys. Ed. OR Ethics/Religious Culture
- ✓ Secondary V Arts

* Please note that Dance credits are attached to Phys. Ed. in Secondary IV and V, to fulfill this graduation requirement.

IMPORTANT: These are the minimum requirements to graduate from high school, but **ADMISSION TO CEGEP IS NOT GUARANTEED.**
