Dear Parents/Guardians,

As you have been informed by Premier Legault, our high schools will be closed Dec 17th and 18th and will only reopen on January 11th, 2021. While our building is **closed**, virtual teaching and learning will continue to take place. We have all become proficient, pivoting from in-person to on-line over the course of this pandemic. This time is no different.

- Your child's schedule will remain the same while on-line Dec 17th, 18th as well as during the week of Jan 4th - Jan 8th, 2021 following the 6-day tumbling timetable. Please consult the school agenda.
- On-line classes will be approximately 30min with support time offered following each period as follows:
 - Approximately 30 minutes direct instruction from the teacher with opportunities for the student to have independent work time.
 - 10 minutes of availability by the classroom teacher attached to each class to support the students.
 - It is important that your child check in with their teachers for class start times and links for Google Classroom and/or Zoom.
- **Teachers will have advised their students which platform they will be using**
- Attendance is mandatory
- It will be important that students check their email and Google Classroom daily.
- Please follow the school days in the agenda carefully.

We are trusting that our students will continue to rise to the occasion and model kindness while attending their online classes. **Our code of conduct** (as outlined in our agenda) **remains in place** and should anyone misuse this opportunity to further their studies, we will have no choice but to remove them temporarily from the on-line platform.

Please remind your child(ren) of the following:

**On-line Learning Behaviour Expectations
2020-2021 School Year**

As part of the school community, it is the responsibility of all students participating in on-line learning to follow the Code of Respect:

- All elements of the school code of conduct are to be respected at all times.
- All elements of the Anti-bullying and Anti-violence plans are in effect at all times.
