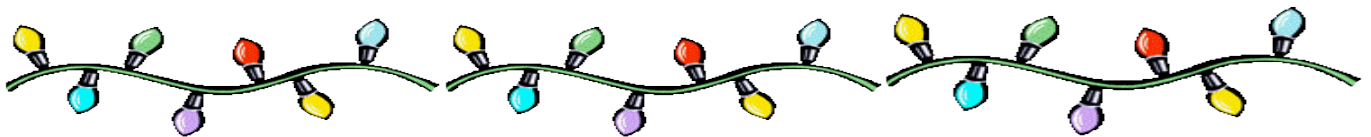
New Student Registration for 2017-18:

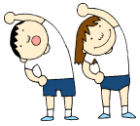
