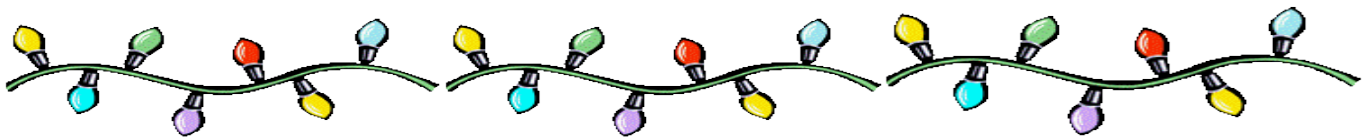
New Student Registration for 2017-18:

Dec 9th: Bottle Flip contest & Staff /Student basketball



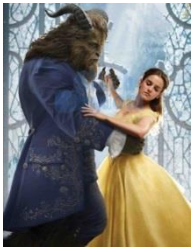
