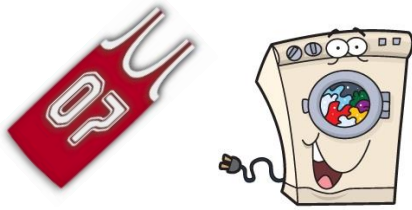


Volleyball: The Volleyball club happens on Friday mornings at 7:45 in the lower gym. Please see Mrs. Zakutney for more information.
