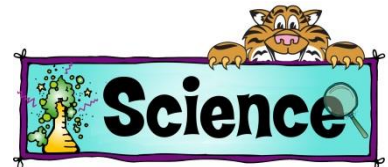
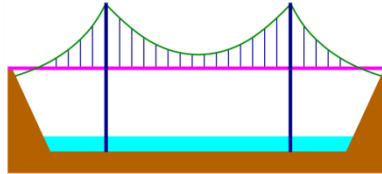




What's happening @ LPHS

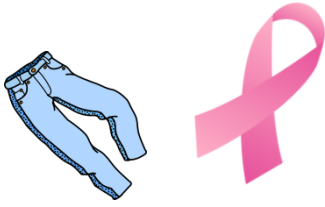
Exams will then take place over the following days (full exam schedule only available May 10). **The last possible day of school and/or exams is June 23rd.**
