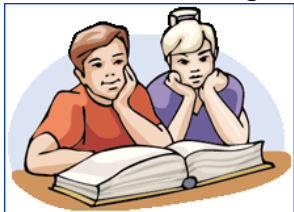
On Tuesday morning they **MUST** bring: the application, **\$14 exact cash** and a proof of identification with a birth date on it (Medicare card, school schedule...).

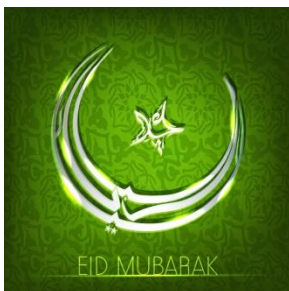
