Intergenerational Project: All students participating in the Intergenerational project events, being held September 12 and September 29, there is no cost to the student. Please meet in the Library for both events.

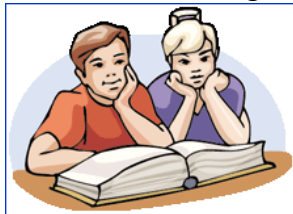


Governing Board Annual General Assembly & ``Meet-The-Teacher`` Night:
