Tickets purchased at lunch will be \$7 each and tickets bought at the door will be \$10 each. Stay tuned to the morning announcements.

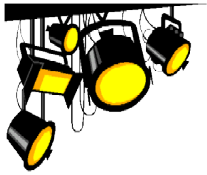


**Grad Scavenger Hunt:** Friday, October 27<sup>th</sup>. Permission forms were sent home this week for this fun filled event.

We kindly ask all students and staff to not throw food in the blue recycling bins. These blue bins are for recyclable products such as paper, cardboard, plastic, glass and not for composting products like food and waste. We also have several brand new boxes throughout the school for empty soda cans, which we will be collected and returned for refund.

**Composting at LPHS:** Thanks to our student-led Green Team, LPHS is using the municipal composting services offered by the city of Pointe Claire. We encourage students to use them for all biodegradable waste, such as food scraps, paper plates, paper napkins etc. Remember that juice boxes and yogurt containers go in the blue recycling bins. Fruit, vegetable and other food waste go in the green compost bins. Thanks so much for helping keep our planet green!
