Grade 10: personal toiletries (shampoo, toothpaste, deodorant, soap...) and household cleaning products

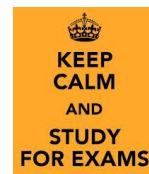
Grade 11: Any canned goods and pet food
