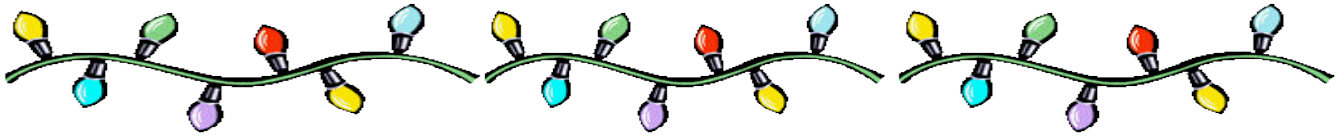


# What's happening @ LPHS
