Term Two Exams: During the week of Jan 29th to Feb 2nd all grade levels will be writing mid-year exams. **Note that this exam schedule has been extended by 1 day compared with the original schedule published in our school calendar (Jan. 29 – Feb. 2 as opposed to Jan. 30 – Feb 2).** The complete exam schedule is attached and is available on the school website. These will be half days and there are no scheduled classes. **Please note that school attendance is compulsory for these exams. A signed Doctor's note will be required in case of illness. Please call the Administration prior to the scheduled exam if your child is sick and will be absent.** School buses will be departing the school at 1 pm each day. **The school cafeteria will be open for breakfast and recess only.**
