**Term 2 Report Cards and Parent Teacher Interviews:** Due to deadlines for submitting secondary 5 marks for SRAM/CEGEP, only the Secondary 5 report cards will be released on Friday, February 16<sup>th</sup> after 4:00 pm via the **Fusion Parental Portal**. All other grade level (secondary 1-4) report cards will be released on Friday, February 23<sup>rd</sup> after 4:00 pm, again through the Fusion Portal. Once all grade level report cards are available for viewing on February the 23<sup>rd</sup>, the Fusion Parent-Teacher Interview appointment booking will open. It will remain open until Wednesday Feb 28<sup>th</sup>, giving parents the ability to book individual teacher appointments for the afternoon and evening of March 1st. More information to follow.
