Once all grade level report cards are available for viewing on February the 23rd, the Fusion Parent-Teacher Interview appointment booking will open. It will remain open until Wednesday Feb 28th, giving parents the ability to book individual teacher appointments for the afternoon and evening of March 1st. **See attached.**

Medical Information:

For your child's health and safety, we have included fields for medical information. By digitizing this information, the school will have instant access to important medical information. This also alleviates the need for parents to fill in a medical form for the school for every situation (e.g., field trips).

The deadline to register your child is February 16th. If your child is NOT returning to LPHS next year you must still fill in the registration and then complete a transfer request form, available from the main office. If your child is leaving the Province/Country, moving out of the LBPSB territory, or registering at a secondary school other than an LBPSB one we would greatly appreciate you completing the registration process to ensure that your child(ren)'s files are finalized and archived properly should you ever need access to them in the future.

Parent/Teacher Interviews:

Following the digital release of Sec 1-4 report cards on February Feb 23rd, parents will be able to book parent/teacher interviews through Fusion. Access to the appointment tab will be open from 4:00 pm February 23 until 4:00 pm February 28th. Interviews will take place on March 1st from 4:00 - 6:00 pm and 7:00 - 9:00 pm **by appointment only**. No appointments will be accepted after the above time.

Registering on Fusion for the first time:

If you have not already done so, creating an account on the Fusion Parental Portal is a two-step process.

1. You will use the link below to go to our Fusion website and create your account.
2. Following the successful creation of your account, you will receive an email with a validation link, and by clicking on that link, you will be returned to the Fusion site to login. Your account is now active.

When you login to Fusion as a parent, you are shown pictures of your child(ren). When selecting a child, you can then view their results such as report cards, bus passes, schedules, etc.

The information required to create your account

1. The email address we sent this notification to, which is the **email address** you provided to the school/centre to contact you at, and is currently in our systems (Note: The same email address that you are receiving email notifications from the school)

2. The ``**Permanent Code**``, often called the ``**QPC**``, of your child (Example: AAAJ01010101). If you have more than one child in our system, you can use any of their codes to create your account (all of your children will be added to your Fusion account). The Permanent Code is only used once for the creation of the account, after that, it is no longer required (Permanent Codes can be found on previous report cards or other official documents).
3. Select the school that your child attends, based on which Permanent Code (QPC) you use.
4. Create a secure password. It is suggested you use a combination of letters, numbers and characters to ensure that your password is as secure as possible.

Please prepare all of the information noted above in advance of using the link to create your account. The LBPSB Fusion Parental Portal is also optimized for smartphones and tablets, so you can access it whenever, wherever and on whatever you wish.
