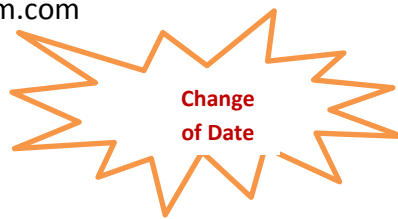
Honour Roll: Term 2 honour roll letters will be distributed next week.
