“First Peoples” Scholarship: The Centre des Premières Nations Nikanite and its partners are setting up “School Perseverance for First Peoples” scholarship funds 2017-2018 to highlight perseverance of First Peoples students.

The scholarships are intended for Secondary 4 and Secondary 5 students. A scholarship will be awarded to deserving students from each of the 11 autochthonous nations to encourage their progress and their daily efforts throughout their school careers.

The deadline to send applications is May 11, 2018. The finalists will appear in the 3rd edition of the Journal of Perseverance and Academic Success for First Peoples, which will be published next December. Please see Mr. Khan in the Guidance area if you wish to apply.
