Last Day of Regular Classes: Friday June 8th we will have regular classes in the morning. Students who ordered and paid for a yearbook as part of their school fees will receive their yearbooks. (**if you are not sure if you paid for a yearbook, please contact the school before Friday) In the afternoon, students are invited to the BBQ taking place in the lower field. Students are encouraged to sit outside, enjoy the sunshine, eat and have their yearbook signed. There will also be a staff/student soccer game taking place on the field. The game will be from 1 p.m. to 2:30 p.m. School buses depart the school at the usual time – 3:55 p.m. Student lockers will need to be emptied by the last day of exams, June 19th. (rehearsal, tutoring, sporting event). There is no supervision of students outside of these hours. Students waiting to be picked up after school should be waiting in the main lobby only.
