On Wednesday morning they **MUST** bring: the application, \$14 exact cash and a proof of identification with a birth date on it (Medicare card, school schedule...).



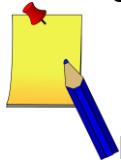
**Early arrivals at LPHS and supervision concerns:** Mrs Payette informed parents at an assembly on Wednesday that students would not be able to access the school before 8:30 a.m. As stated in the agenda, the school doors are in fact open after 7:45 a.m. however we want to stress that there is no supervision before 8:30 a.m. and students who do arrive early should remain in the main lobby for safety reasons.



We would like to remind everyone that there is **No Parking** in the school bus loading area (entrance off St. John Fisher road) or behind the school near the large dumpster.



We would like to remind everyone that there is **No smoking** permitted anywhere on school property. This is a city Bylaw. The school and the individual could face large fines if caught.

Following an absence from school, we kindly ask you to write a confirmation note in the agenda upon the student's return, regardless of whether you called the absence line at school.
