Dear Parents and Guardians,

Thank you for your cooperation in prioritizing safety for all. Our collaboration is key to supporting wellness for our students and staff.

Your diligence is appreciated moving forward. When a student exhibits possible Covid 19 symptoms, no matter how minor they may seem, we are all in the process of assessing whether the child needs to 1) stay home, 2) go home if they are at school, 3) whether a letter must be sent to the class asking all parents to monitor their child.

It is imperative that parents keep their child home if they are ill and to notify the school of the absence with details of all symptoms. This will support us with the safety and security of our community. We are also asking parents to call the COVID line 1 877 644-4545 and follow the recommendations of Public Health. The experts will tell you if your child needs to be tested and next steps to be taken.

Symptoms of COVID-19

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Onset or aggravation of a cough • Fever (38 C or more, oral thermometer) • Difficulty breathing • Sudden loss of smell without congestion or loss of taste 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • General symptoms (muscular pain, headache, intense fatigue or loss of appetite) • Nasal congestion and/or nasal drip • Sore throat • Diarrhea or gastro intestinal symptoms • Vomiting or abdominal pain

In the event that a close family member has tested positive for Covid 19, Public Health will guide you and we ask you to please inform the school immediately so steps can be taken locally.
