Vaccinations: Given the progression of the Covid 29 virus, public health has determined that all school vaccination campaigns must be cancelled and postponed until next year. Vaccinations that were scheduled to take place at LPHS on October 7th and 8th have been cancelled.



School Photos: Photographers will be at the school on October 9th to take student photos. These are some of the enhanced cleaning protocols being implemented for Picture Day to ensure camera stations are sanitized and safe for students.

- 1) Sanitizing wipes and sprays will be used on all set-up materials and equipment at the beginning and end of day.
- 2) During photography, equipment used or touched by subjects will be sanitized.
- 3) Pre-moistened alcohol wipes will be used on the camera's viewfinder and high-touch areas on the camera.
- 4) Hand Sanitizer will be frequently used by our photographers throughout the day.
