**Weather:** As cooler weather is upon us, we remind parents and students that due to COVID-19, they are not permitted in the school before 8:50am. During lunch and recess students have a choice to go outside or stay in their class. Those who go outside are to remain outside for the duration. We must reduce the flow of traffic in and out of the building and in the hallways. Appropriate grade level doors should be used when exiting and entering the building. It is understood that should the weather take a turn for the worst while outside, students will be permitted to come in.

Should you drive your child to school, please do let them out of the car until 8:50 to avoid students conglomerating on school property.

Our parking lot is busy in the morning and after school. We require everyone's cooperation to slow down to maintain safety for all.

**Online Learning Sec 4 & 5:** As was announced by the Minister of Education and communicated to you last week, Secondary 4 & 5 students are required to do online schooling from home every second day.

- Gr. 10 are **online: Days 1, 3, & 5** and they are **in school Days 2, 4 & 6**
- Gr. 11 are **online: Days 2, 4 & 6** and they are **in school Days 1, 3, & 5**

**Lunch:** We kindly ask parents to also avoid delivering food to your child during the school day as parents/visitors are not permitted in the building and this causes frequent disruptions to our staff. Thank you for your cooperation.

Please note that students are **not** permitted to order food to be delivered to the school at any time during the school day. This has long been our policy in the past as it poses a security concern as well as violating our Covid 19 safety policies and visitor restrictions.

**Covid 19 Protocols:** The Minister has added **new restrictions and safety protocols** for high schools. Students must wear their mask when outside on school property and while in the classroom, unless they are eating, drinking or during PhysEd. We also ask students to bring extra masks in case of loss, contamination or breakage.

This also applies to when they are working from home online as attendance is taken.****
