




What's happening @ LPHS



Back to School: On Jan. 18th, we will resume classes in the school building.

As announced by the government, all students will be provided with 2 medical/procedural masks everyday that they are in our building. Students should have a face covering/mask when leaving their home, and must wear it as soon as they are on school property. Students are reminded to bring a paper bag or a ziplock bag to safely store the extra masks. Once they are in their homeroom class, their teacher will issue their 2 medical/procedural masks which students must wear at all times, unless they are seated while eating in their class bubble. We recommend they change their mask after lunch and wear the second mask home after school, disposing of the mask once home. If your child arrives late to school, they will receive their masks from the main office when they sign in.



If your child has ANY COVID 19 symptoms, please follow public health directives and DO NOT SEND THEM TO SCHOOL. Should you or anyone in your household show any symptoms for COVID - testing is recommended immediately. You are no longer to wait 24 hours. Absences should still be reported while online learning. When calling the school to report an absence, please be as specific as possible when explaining the reason. If you have Covid-19 symptoms to report and are going to a testing clinic, please leave the information on our answering service. This is essential for our documentation and tracking.

Ministry Exams: The Minister of Education has announced that Ministry formal exams will not be taking place this year. We want to encourage all students to give their best effort as every evaluation now becomes important for term and final marks.
