Re-Registration: The registration period for the **2021-22 school year** is from **1-5 February**. Every Lindsay Place student will automatically be recognized in the Parent Mozaik Portal for 2021-2022 as a St-Thomas High School student in the Broadview building. There is an opportunity to request for transfers but rest assured that all students can continue to attend school at the Broadview building as St-Thomas High School students, for the 2021-2022 school year. Re registration is the first step in this process. More information about St Thomas options and programs will be forthcoming as Option selection will be at a later date.



If your child has ANY COVID 19 symptoms, please follow public health directives and **DO NOT SEND THEM TO SCHOOL**. Should you or anyone in your household show **ONE** of any symptoms for COVID listed below - testing is recommended immediately along with isolation. You are no longer to wait 24 hours.

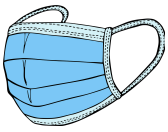
COVID 19 symptoms:

1. Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
2. Feeling feverish or body temperature equal to or over 38°
3. Chills
4. Sore throat
4. Nasal congestion and/or nasal drip
5. Diarrhea
6. Muscular pain or body aches (not related to exercise)
7. Headache
8. Vomiting or abdominal pain
9. Sudden loss of smell and/or taste without congestion
10. Fatigue or weakness
11. Loss of appetite
12. Onset or worsening of a cough

Absences should still be reported while online learning. When calling the school to report an absence, please be as specific as possible when explaining the reason. If you have Covid-19 symptoms to report and are going to a testing clinic, please leave the information on our answering service. This is essential for our documentation and tracking.



CLASS BUBBLE OPEN GYM: Starting on Tuesday, Feb 2nd , we will be offering an “Open Gym” for students during the second half of their lunch hour. Individual class bubbles will have assigned days. This is optional for all students and the activity will change monthly. They will be brought to and from the gym by a supervisor and all safety protocols will be observed. The schedule will be posted on the gym doors on Monday and students are invited to listen to the morning announcements for further details.



MASKS: All students are provided with 2 medical/procedural masks everyday that they are in our building. Students should have a face covering/mask when leaving their home, and must wear it as soon as they are on school property. Students are reminded to bring a paper bag or a ziplock bag to safely store the extra masks. Their Homeroom teacher will issue their 2 **government issued procedural masks which students must wear at all times**, unless they are seated while eating in their class bubble.
