**Ministerial directive:** As we previously communicated, the Minister of Education has mandated that all high school students return to full time in-person learning. Please follow the schedule below:

- **March 31- April 1st:** No changes for Sec I and II. All **Secondary III** students will attend on a regular schedule in the school. **Secondary IV-V** will continue to attend as per our current school plan, still following their in school and on-line schedules.
- **April 7th :** **Secondary IV-V** will begin attending school on a regular schedule in school full time. **Therefore, all grades will be present in school full time as of April 7th .**

**Please note:** As of April 7th, all Sec IV and V Students will be required to enter the building by the front main entrance due to construction. **For the safety of all, no cars or students are permitted in the back parking lot.**



**Motorized vehicles :** Students who bring a car or motorized vehicle (scooter, moped) to school are asked to please park in the parking lot across the street and must register the vehicle at the main office.

### COVID 19 symptoms:

1. Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
2. Feeling feverish or body temperature equal to or over 38°
  3. Chills
  4. Sore throat
4. Nasal congestion and/or nasal drip
  5. Diarrhea
6. Muscular pain or body aches (not related to exercise)
  7. Headache
8. Vomiting or abdominal pain
9. Sudden loss of smell and/or taste without congestion
  10. Fatigue or weakness
  11. Loss of appetite
12. Onset or worsening of a cough
