Dear Parents,

As you know from emails sent to you last week, due to a strike on the part of school bus drivers working for Transco, there will be no school bus service for most of our routes on Tuesday, Jan. 30 and Wednesday, Jan. 31. The routes that will be affected for Lindsay Place High School are:

**018 020 021 022 023 024 039 043 044 045 069**

We want to remind you about the following points:

-For students who come to school by the affected school bus routes, you will have to find alternate means of transportation, such as carpooling or using the services of the STM. Links to city bus routes that provide public transportation very close to LPHS follow at the end of this memo.

-Our exam schedule will proceed as planned. Students will still be expected to arrive at school in time for their exams each day.

**-Since there will be no buses to transport students home at the end of the day, students will be dismissed at the end of their exams on Tuesday and Wednesday. Most exams end at 12:00, but please note that the dismissal time for individual students will vary; please consult the exam schedule posted on our website and facebook page to see when your child will be dismissed from school on these two days.**

-We are asking all parents to be aware of this situation, and to anticipate heavier than normal car traffic Tuesday and Wednesday during morning drop off/afternoon pick up. We ask your cooperation and patience in managing the extra volume of traffic.

-If it is possible for you to drop your child off at school earlier than 8:55, this will be helpful. School doors will open as usual at 7:45 a.m.

-We also ask you to please consider using a location nearby LPHS (using Belmont Ave., John Fisher Ave., Summerhill Ave. or Valois Bay Ave.) other than the front entrance on Broadview for drop-off and pick up. This will help reduce traffic directly in front of the main entrance.

-We have asked Pointe Claire public security to be present at drop off and pick up times to help with traffic control.
